Whereas, a student must be paid at least the Federal minimum wage under the Federal Work Study Program as required by 34 cfr 675.24(b), and under 34 cfr 675.20(c), the student's work must also be governed by employment conditions including pay, that are appropriate in terms of, among other things, the applicable federal, state, or local law; and

Whereas, government institutions are not subject to the provisions of the state's Minimum Wage Act, pursuant to the state regulation 12 NYCPR section 142-2.14(b); and

Whereas, Nassau Community College is committed to provide opportunities at competitive rates to Nassau Community College students participating in the Federal Work Study Program or employed as student aids; and
