#### **ADMINISTRATION OF NARCAN**

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#### **SUMMARY**

The procedures listed below are promulgated to ensure that the College is in full compliance with its Student Health Office Policy (Policy 5300), Section J "\*ToCf o kpkutckqp" qh" P cmzqpg" \*P ctecp+ö+:

### **DEFINITIONS**

- A. **Drug overdose:** Impaired mental or physical functioning as a result of the use of physiological and/or psychoactive substances, i.e.: euphoria, dysphoria, apathy, sedation, attention impairment.
- B. **Naloxone** (Narcan): An FDA approved nasal spray, which is an opiate receptor antagonist (a blocker). Narcan serves as an antidote for opiate or heroin overdose.

## **PROCESS**

A. Permission to carry and administer Narcan on College property shall be limited to trained Public Safety Officers and Eqngi g"J gcnj "Qhhegøu Licensed Professional Nurses in all cases of suspected drug overdoses (hereinafter the õEqngi g"Hktu/Tgur qpf gtuö+.

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
